

Father Bob Answers Your Questions About The “I Make All Things New” Campaign

Fr. Bob, can you please tell me what happens if the parish raises more than the \$1,000,000 goal?

Absolutely. First of all, I do fully expect our parish to raise more than the goal because the campaign is going very well. The match we have from a benefactor will be depleted once we raise \$1,000,000. All additional funds will be used to finance areas that were not originally included in our plan.

We would love to build the \$127,000 bell tower that is designed after the bell tower on the Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi in Assisi. The cross will sit atop the bell tower for all to see. It will house a speaker system to imitate a bell, similar to what the Presbyterians use now. The structure will be built to house a real bell if sometime in the future the parish has the money to put a real bell into the tower.

The \$274,000 multipurpose room and kitchenette will be used for Sunday morning coffee and donuts and small pancake breakfasts. I see it also being used to support any outdoor activities we may have at the new site while we prepare to build the next buildings. The room is designed to have a storage area and seating for about 125 people at round tables. The kitchenette will not be a full commercial kitchen. A commercial kitchen will come when

we build the future social hall. This is meant as a warming kitchen and small meals. It would also be used if we had a caterer bring food into the building as a staging area.

I pray that our faithful parishioners will generate the funds to fully build these optional, but necessary parts of our building.
