

BLESSED SACRAMENT CHURCH
PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES
2-10/2010

The meeting convened with Fr. Bob leading the prayer "Rebuild my Church".

The role call reflected all present with the exception of Alice Fairchild.

Fr. Bob reported that we had agreed to help with the Times-News project for Haiti. The funds would come out of our outreach collections. In addition we will be asking for volunteers to load trucks.

Fr. Bob reported that we have approximately 97% of our Bishops Annual Appeal goal pledged.

Fr. Bob reported that the Capital Campaign for the building of the Church is going very well.

Fr. Bob indicated that at a recent Priest's Council meeting he was approached by a fellow priest that was giving a San Damiano Cross which was no longer needed. Fr. Bob would meet and secure delivery of the Cross for the new Church.

The council discussed individuals who might be available to chair the Parish Council selection committee for upcoming open positions. Fr. Bob to email possible candidates names to the Council.

It was decided that the next meeting would be held March 10, 2010.

Extensive discussion ensued regarding Committee chairs and the following names were agreed upon.

- 1) Facilities/Environment – David Farrell
- 2) Liturgy/Spirituality – Mary Key Roach
- 3) Parish Communications – Rosale Papandrea
- 4) Education – Lynn Snook and Tanya Byerly
- 5) Discipleship – Ann Imrick

It was discussed that we would put the chairs on the email list for agenda items. Ann suggested that we should spell out in a document to chairs the responsibilities of their respective committees. Mike will draft letter for Fr. Bob to review.

The Council discussed the formation of an ad-hoc transition committee to handle details involved in moving to the new Church. It was decided that Dan Wright would be asked to chair the committee, which would include Church staff and other individuals to be suggested.

Future agenda items were discussed to include Building the Church, continuity, expanding membership and training ministries.

There being no further business before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 8:35PM.
